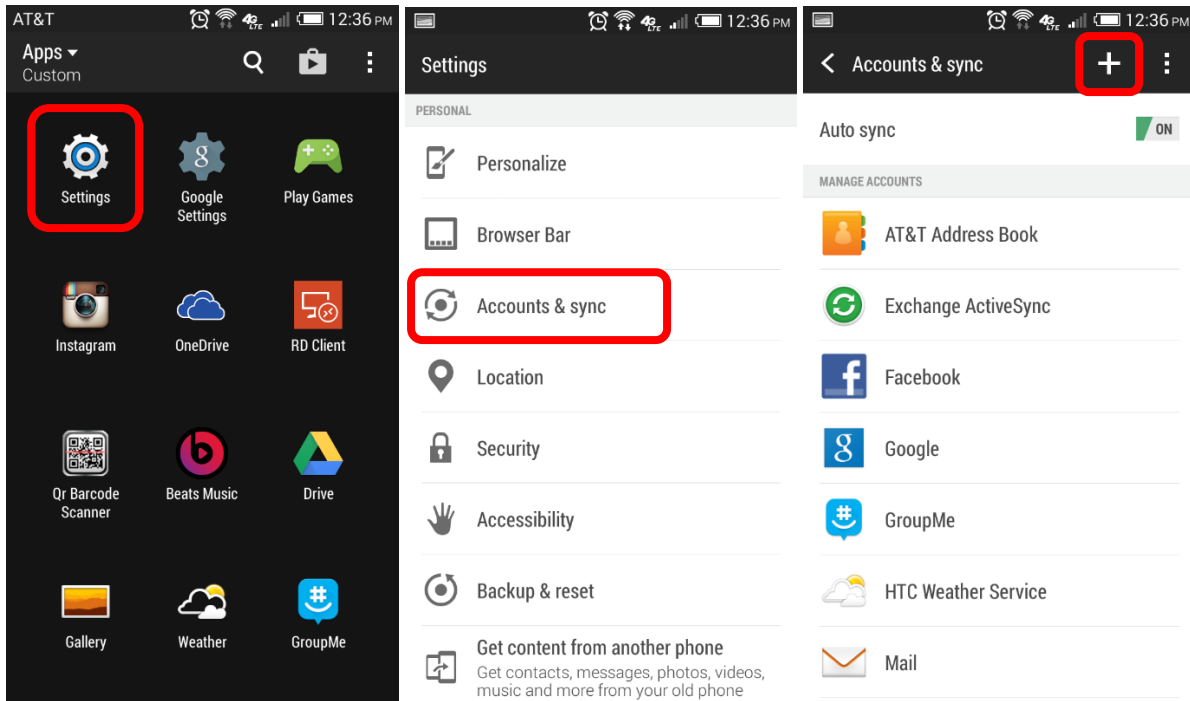
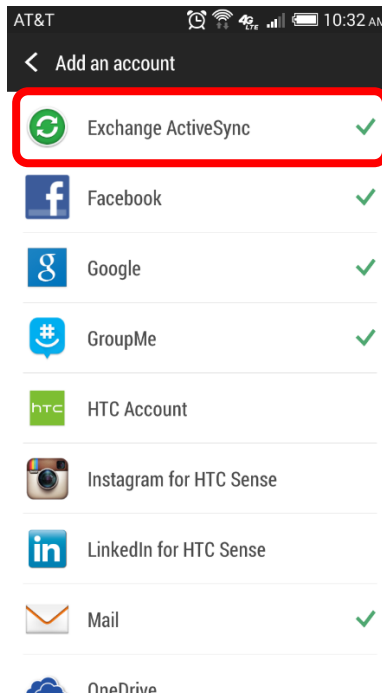


Exchange ActiveSync for Android

From the Android Menu, go to **Settings** and choose **Accounts & Sync**. Select the **Add Account** icon.



Then select **Exchange ActiveSync**.



While setting up your Exchange ActiveSync account, make sure to input the following information:

Email Address: **YourNID@ucf.edu**

Server Address: **webmail.ucf.edu**

Domain: **NET**

Username: **Your NID**

Password: **Your NID Password**

Then customize your account settings, and give a name to your account. Then **Finish Setup**.
